What happens on the day

As a fire walker you will receive full training an hour before the fire walk. During this time you will be motivated and build the confidence to complete the challenge. FAQ's

How much does it cost?

To reserve your place there is an entry fee of £30. We then ask you to try to raise a minimum sponsorship of £70. In return you will receive a certificate and a GKCCT medal.

What time do I have to get there and where do I go?

The fire walk will take place at Asztec, Worcester Road, Upton Warren, Bromsgrove, B61 7ER. There is car parking available.

We are asking fire walkers to arrive at 6.00pm. There will be an hour long training seminar at 6.30pm.

Can I bring my family and friends?

Yes of course. The more people we have there giving encouragement to our fire walkers the better! Please bear in mind any current covid restrictions that may be in place at the time.

Why should I walk on fire?

We will never give you justification of why you should walk on fire, the choice is always your own, however walking on fire gives people different results from overcoming their fears, self fulfilment, spiritual awakening or just a wonderful experience.

Can I burn walking on fire?

There are various degrees of burns, from minor small blisters to third degree burns. The common denominator of those who do burn is that they all believed they would. We are pleased to say at UK Fire Walk we have never had anyone who required medical attention after our public, corporate or charity fire walks. However, there is always a risk with fire walking. If there are no risks, where would be the challenge and accomplishment of walking on fire be?

How hot are the coals?

The temperature of the coals can be as hot as 1200 degrees Fahrenheit. Put into perspective: paper combusts at 451 degrees, aluminium melts at 1100 degrees, sausages on the other hand....

Who can walk on fire?

Anyone can walk on fire, providing they feel they can. People aged from 4 to 98 years old have walked on fire.

What is the hardest part?

The hardest thing to overcome is the fear of taking the first step!

What are the added benefits?

Fire walking is richly rewarding in terms of your personal self development and the activation of your potential, realise and focus your talents, make decisions, set goals, awaking and exercising inner strength to expand your conscious awareness beyond everyday experiences. You will discover meaning, prioritise the important things, understand the purpose of your life.

Conditions of entry

Registration

You must sign up online via our website. The non-refundable entry fee covers all expenses and insurance for the fire walk. Participants under 16 years old must be accompanied by an adult during the event. Grace Kelly Childhood Cancer Trust reserves the right to refuse entry to the Fire Walk to any person.

Cancellations

In the unforeseeable event that the Fire Walk cannot take place on Friday 15th October 2021 every attempt will be made to rearrange the date. Refunds will only be given if the Fire walk is unavoidably cancelled by the Grace Kelly Childhood Cancer Trust. If you cannot take part in the fire walk once you have registered you must contact the team on 01905 885777 as soon as possible.

Alcohol

Alcohol must not be consumed before the fire walk or brought onto the premises of Aztec to consume during the event. Entry will be refused to anyone who is under the influence of alcohol or other substances.

Health and safety

The Grace Kelly Childhood Cancer Trust to the extent permitted by law, exclude liability for loss, damage, injury, consequential loss suffered by any entrant personally or to their property as a result of their entry to or participation in the fire walk. All entrants must take responsibility for their own health and safety. You must pay full attention at all times and listen to the guidelines of the fire walk Officials.

Medical conditions

All entrants must take responsibility for their own health. If you have any medical conditions that may affect your participation in the fire walk please consult your doctor before signing up.

Due to the nature of the event, the fire walk may not be suitable for people with a disability. Please contact the Team on 01905 885777 to check whether the fire walk is feasible.

Clothing and footwear

You must wear comfortable clothing during the event and it will be outdoors so you may want to bring a coat. Regarding the footwear, well...you'll be taking your shoes off anyway!

If you are bringing friends and family with you tell them to wrap up warm!

Animals

Dogs are not permitted at this event.
